Quotes & Scheduled Pickups: How to avoid delays and double work

Logistics is all about speed and efficiency. IL2000 and carriers play a significant role in keeping shipments moving, but there are things you can do to ensure your quotes and scheduled pickups go as planned.

Most important is to include all the necessary information.

Quotes: Include the following info when making a quote:

- Origin and destination zip code
- Piece count/handling unit (such as loose pallets and rolls)
- **Description** of freight (Helpful with class or dimensions questions.)
- Class of freight
- Weight
- Dimensions
- When the freight is available for **pickup**
- When the freight needs to be **delivered** (This may prompt different types of shipping, such as expedited or dedicated, when timelines are tight.)
- Any accessorial required (such as liftgate, appointment, delivery to military base, or special equipment)

Scheduling a Pickup: Include all of the above, plus:

- The **full address** for the shipper and consignee
- **Contact info** for shipper and consignee (email/phone)
- Freight billing terms (prepaid, collect, or third party)
- Reference numbers / PO
- Special instructions
